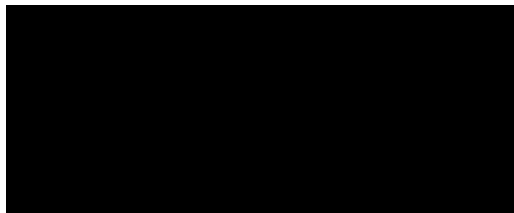

TAKING CARE OF BUSINESS!

Check with Ms. Bricker in the Budget and Accounting Office to see if anything is posted on your records (fines/fees).

Check in Library to clear fines and return books (all items are due May 9th).

A clearance receipt will be given to you when your final checkout from school is completed. This is your receipt for final clearance for graduation and must be presented before picking up your cap and gown. **Please note: Early graduates (completers) students will also need a clearance receipt.**

APRIL 28TH IS THE LAST DAY SENIORS CAN PAY FEES/FINES WITH A CHECK AND RECEIVE THEIR DIPLOMA AT GRADUATION

MAY 8TH IS THE LAST DAY SENIORS CAN PAY FEES/FINES WITH CREDIT CARDS AND RECEIVE THEIR DIPLOMA AT GRADUATION

Seniors not given final clearance will be allowed to participate in graduation ceremonies, but will **not** receive their diploma until all financial obligations have been satisfied.

Payment for cap and gown is to be paid to Jostens (242-5030). Caps/gowns may be picked up in the wrestling room on Wednesday, May 10th, from 9:00 – 11:30 a.m. after final clearance.

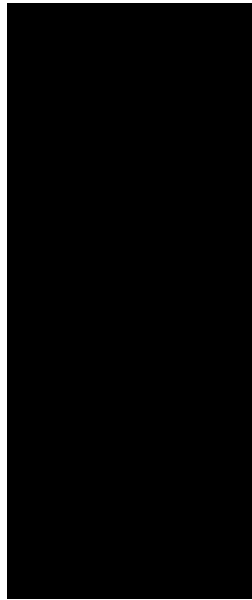


Requests for final transcripts MUST be done through your Naviance account on or before final checkout day 5/10/17. This step is very important, so please do not delay. THIS INCLUDES NCAA CLEARINGHOUSE REQUESTS!

If you do not plan to participate in the Commencement exercise, please notify Mr. Powell by April 28th of your intentions. A statement bearing the signature of parent/guardian is required.

Participation in graduation practice is MANDATORY! You MUST attend the entire practice.

Outstanding books or calculators not collected by April 28th will show on your fee statement on your check-out sheet. Once items are collected, the fees will be removed. All fees must be paid in order to for diplomas to be awarded.
