Class Prerequisites: Yes, this is super important for you to know, as it impacts the classes you are able to take next year!

The following classes have prerequisites. Counselors will not register you for the classes unless you have met them.

Business

- Computer Science Explorations or its equivalent is a prerequisite for all other computer classes, including Graphic Design.

English

- AP English Language and AP English Literature**-Successful completion of 9th & 10th grade English Composition courses
- CMU English 111**-PSAT/SAT score of 470 on English or Accuplacer/ACT equivalency
- CMU English 112**- Successful completion of English 111 (C or higher)/AP English with qualifying scores and PSAT/SAT score of 470 on English or Accuplacer/ACT equivalency

Math

- Accuplacer Math**- Must have completed through Math 3
- CMU Math 113**- Must have completed through Math 3 and have PSAT/SAT of at least 500 in math section (or equivalency)

Science

- Anatomy & Physiology**-Completion of Environmental Science & Biology (must pass Biology with C or above)-Chemistry recommended
- Astronomy**-Completion of Math 1/Algebra 1
- Chemistry**- Math 2/Geometry completed with a C or above and either have completed or be enrolled concurrently in Algebra II/Math 3
- Chemistry in the Community (Chem Comm)**-Enviro Science & Biology completed and Math 1/Algebra 1 completed with C or above
- STEM Discovery: OWL Leadership Class** -Completion of Environmental Science; 10-12th graders only
- Zoology**-Completion of Enviro Science & Biology
- AP Biology**-Honors Biology completed with a grade of C or better and Chemistry (may be in Chemistry concurrently)-This means that if you HAVE NOT ALREADY completed Chemistry, you will HAVE to take Chemistry along with AP Biology. It is recommended (although not required) that students take Anatomy & Physiology and/or Zoology and/or Botany and/or Environmental Science prior to taking AP Biology
- AP Chemistry**-Completion of Math 3/Algebra 2
- AP Environmental Science**-Completion of Biology with an A or B or Biology concurrently-This means that if you HAVE NOT ALREADY taken Biology, you will HAVE to take Biology along with AP Environmental.
- AP Physics**-Math 2/Geometry completed
- River Dynamics**- Completion of Environmental Science and Biology

Technology Ed

- Applied Engineering**-Engineering Design
- Architectural/Structural Design**-Engineering Design
- Engineering Design**-Intro to STEM
- Intro to Surveying**-Completion of Math 3 with a C or above
- Robotics**—Intro to STEM & Math 2
- Mechatronics**-Completion of Intro to STEM; 10-12th graders only

Visual Arts

- Art I** is required to be taken before any other art class EXCEPT Ceramics
- Drawing & Painting II**-Drawing & Painting I
- Ceramics II**-Ceramics I
- Advanced Art/Art Journaling**-Art I & at least 2 other art classes

Performing Arts

- Music Theory**-Must have a musical background and be able to read music
- Advanced Acting: Improv**-must have taken Beg Acting (10-12th graders only)
- Advanced Acting: Performance**—must have taken Advanced Acting: Improv or previously been in Advanced Acting
- Jazz I, Jazz II, and Marching Band**-Students must also be in either Symphonic Band or Wind Ensemble to be in these classes

PE

- Lifetime Activities**-Must have driver's license and the ability to drive self off campus for a variety of activities
